### **Shortage of Personal Coaches**

#### **1634. SHRI K. PARASURAMAN:**

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is providing training to many Indian sportspersons through Sports Authority of India (SAI) to enable them to excel in the coming Olympic games;
- (b) if so, whether there is shortage of personal coaches for those sportspersons who are under training with SAI;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and whether the Government has also provided personal coaches in foreign countries to the Indian sportspersons; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the financial implications met by the Government under this mission till now?

- (b) to (d): No, Madam. There is no shortage of coaches for the elite Indian athletes preparing for International events including Rio Olympics, 2016. As per the requirement of the athletes/teams, in addition to services of reputed Indian Coaches/Experts, 38 Foreign

Coaches/Experts have been engaged for the training of Indian athletes / teams in India. Athletes are also provided services of coaches in foreign countries.

Financial grant on the preparation of Indian sportspersons / teams including for foreign coaches / experts during last three years is given below:-

i) Year 2013-14 - Rs. 160.81 Crores

ii) Year 2014-15 - Rs. 165.30 Crores

iii) Year 2015-16 - Rs. 190.61 Crores

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
