LOSSES IN RAILWAYS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the estimated losses in passenger segment of the Railways has ballooned over the years and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether this is primarily due to sharp increases in input costs and no proportionate increase in fares over the same period; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

 (a): Yes, Madam. The estimated losses in passenger segment of the Railways have increased from ₹6159 crore in 2004-05 to ₹32458 crore in 2014-15.

(b)&(c): Yes, Madam. The input cost of passenger services has increased in 2014-15 by 272% over 2004-05, whereas the earnings has increased in 2014-15 by 205% over 2004-05.
