Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the training centre scheme implemented by the Sports Authority of India in the country;**
- (b) the number of sportspersons who availed the benefits of the said scheme across the country during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UTwise;**
- (c) the details of the funds provided under the said scheme during the said period, State/UT-wise;**
- (d) whether the Government proposes to open such centres in various States including Jharkhand and if so, the details thereof along with the locations where such centres are proposed to be opened;**
- (e) whether the cases of corruption/ irregularities/diversion of funds in implementation of the said scheme have come to the notice of the Government during the said period and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise; and**

(f) the other steps taken by the Government for effective implementation of the said scheme across the country?

(a) Madam, Sports Authority of India (SAI) is implementing the following sports promotional schemes to identify talented sports persons in the age group of 8-25 years and nurture them to excel at national and international competitions:

- **National Sports Talent Contest Scheme (NSTC)**
- **Army Boys Sports Company (ABSC)**
- **SAI Training Centre (STC)**
- **Special Area Games (SAG)**
- **Extension Centre of STC/SAG**
- **Centre of Excellence (CoE)**
- **National Sports Academies (NSA)**

SAI has established 10 Regional Centres and 02 educational institutions to implement the above sports promotional schemes in the country through 251 SAI sports centres. Presently, 11773 talented sports persons (6626 boys and 5147girls) are being trained in 27 sports disciplines on the residential and non residential basis.

The selected trainees are provided with facilities in the form of expert coaches, sports equipment, boarding and lodging, sports kit, competition exposure, educational expenses, medical / insurance and stipend as per the approved scheme norms.

A brief on SAI Sports Promotional Schemes is provided at Annexure - I.

(b) The details of sports persons availing the benefits under the SAI Sports Promotional Schemes across the country during the last three years are provided at Annexure – II.

(c) The details of funds provided under the schemes during the last three years are provided at Annexure – III, IV and V.

(d) The Governing Body of SAI has also approved the following new SAI Centres to be established during 2016-17:

- Special Area Games Centre at Dandeli, Karwar District, Karnataka (for Siddi Tribes)**
- Special Area Games Centre at Kargil, J&K**
- Special Area Games Centre at Lakshdweep**
- Restoration of SAI Training Centre at Hazaribagh, Jharkhand**
- 05 new Boys Sports Company (BSC) Centres in collaboration with Army/Navy/Air Force**

(e) Yes Madam. The details of such cases during the last three years is given in Annexure-VI. The accounts of the field units are being audited by the duly engaged CA and subsequently, the accounts are being audited by the CAG for ensuring standards of financial propriety.

(f) For making the schemes more beneficial and for their effective implementation so as to gain optimum benefits, the review of the schemes is a continuous process. However, the selection criteria of all the schemes was specifically reviewed by a committee of experts during 2015-16. Based on the recommendation of the experts committee, the Financial Norms and Selection Criteria were revised and, after the approval of the Competent Authority, notified for implementation during 2016-17.

BRIEF NOTES ON THE SCHEMES ARE GIVEN BELOW:-

1. NATIONAL SPORTS TALENT CONTEST:- Regular Schools: The main concept of the scheme is to PLAY & STUDY in the same school Scientific scouting of talent at optimum age essential for converting the genetically and physiologically gifted children into future medal hopes in various competitions at National and International level. The children in the age group of 8-14 years are admitted under the Scheme. Presently there are **13** regular schools, **11** schools for Promotion of Indigenous Games & Martial Arts and **40** Akharas adopted under the scheme. Presently there are **13** NSTC Regular Schools in the country having a total strength of **447** trainees (**323 Boys & 124 Girls**).

Presently under the scheme selected trainees are admitted on non-residential basis and provided stipend @Rs.3000/- per head per annum. Trainees under the schemes are provided Sports Kit of @Rs.2000/- p.a., Insurance @Rs.150/- p.a., Competition Exposure, @Rs.2000/- p.a., annual grant to the school for purchase of sports equipment Rs.20,000/-.

(a) INDIGENOUS GAMES & MARTIAL ARTS: India is an ancient country with a rich cultural heritage and there are many traditional games popular in the country. Practitioners of these games are on the decline and need was felt for its revival. Trainees are provided with Stipend @Rs.3000/- per head per annum, Sports Kit of @Rs.1500/- p.a., Insurance @Rs.150/- p.a., annual grant to the school for purchase of sports equipment Rs.20,000/- and Rs.25000/- p.a. for Organizing Competition for Scouting Talent. Presently there are **11** IGMA Schools in the country having a total strength of **148** trainees (**79 Boys & 69 Girls**).

(b) ADOPTED AKHARAS: Wrestling has been a traditional indigenous sport in the country and mostly played at village level. In order to create a broader base for modern wrestling SAI has adopted 40 Akharas with about 20-30 Wrestlers each. The adopted Akharas are provided with one set of Wrestling Mat and/or Multi-Gym. The trainees in the Akharas are provided a stipend of Rs.1000/- p.m. & Insurance @Rs.150/- to supplement their diet etc. Presently there are 40 Akharas in the country having a total strength of 503 trainees (444 Boys & 59 Girls).

2. ARMY BOYS SPORTS COMPANY : With a view to utilize the disciplined atmosphere of Army and infrastructure available, Army Boys Sports Company Scheme was introduced in association with Army in which children are identified in the age group of 8-14 years and admitted in the Scheme. The identified trainees are absorbed in the Army, once they attain a required age of 17½ years. At present there are **18** ABSCs. Training is imparted in 18 disciplines. The children admitted under the schemes are provided with Boarding lodging @Rs.175/- per day for 330 days, Sports Kit @Rs.2000/- p.a., Insurance @Rs.150/- p.a., Competition Exposure @Rs.2000/- p.a., Medical Expenses @Rs.300/-, Educational Expenses @Rs.1000/- p.a., one time grant of @Rs.2000/- to a New Trainee. The companies are provided annual grant of Rs.50000/- for purchase of sports equipment & maintenance of play fields. Presently there are **18** BSCs in the country having a total strength of **1201** trainees (**1201 Boys**).

3. SAI TRAINING CENTRE: In order to groom the junior level sports persons in the age group of 12-18 years, with the assistance of State Governments, SAI Training Centres are established in which the State Government needs provide all the infrastructure facilities. SAI is running the scheme by providing scientific training to the selected trainees. At present there are 57 STC Centers. The training is imparted in 25 disciplines. Trainees under residential schemes are provided with Boarding lodging @Rs.175/- for Non-Hilly & @Rs.200/- for Hilly Areas per head per day for 330 days, (**Lum sum Rs.12000/-** for Sports Kit of Rs.5000/- p.a., Insurance @Rs.150/- p.a., Competition Exposure, @Rs.3000/- p.a., Educational Expenses @Rs.1000/- p.a., Medical expenses @Rs.300/- p.a., Other Expense @Rs.100/-) per head and under non-residential scheme are provided Sports Kit @Rs.4000/- p.a. Competition Exposure @Rs.3000/- p.a., Stipend @Rs.6000/- and Insurance @Rs.150/-. Presently there are **58** STC Centres in the country having a total strength of **5625** trainees (**3894 Boys & 1731 Girls**).

4. SPECIAL AREA GAMES: The schemes of Special Area Games aim to scout and nurture the natural talent for modern competitive sports and games from inaccessible tribal, rural and coastal areas of the country. The training is imparted in 25 disciplines. The children are admitted in the age group of 12-18 years in Individual Games, 10-14 years in team game and 12-14 years for sports person having genetic advantage. There are **19** SAG Centers all over the country. The trainees under residential schemes are provided with Boarding lodging @Rs.175/- for Non-Hilly & @Rs.200/- for Hilly Areas per head per day for 330 days, **Lum sum Rs.12000/-** for (Sports Kit Rs.5000/- p.a., Insurance @Rs.150/- p.a., Competition Exposure, @Rs.3000/- p.a., Educational Expenses @Rs.1000/- p.a., Medical expenses @Rs.300/- p.a., Other Expense @Rs.100/-) per head and under non-residential scheme are provided Sports Kit @Rs.4000/- p.a. Competition Exposure @Rs.3000/- p.a., Stipend @Rs.6000/- and Insurance @Rs.150/-. Presently there are **19** SAG Centres in the country having a total strength of **1862** trainees (**1055 Boys & 807 Girls**).

5. EXTENSION CENTERS OF STC /SAG CENTERS TO COVER SCHOOL AND COLLEGES FOR WIDER COVERAGE: The aim of the scheme is to develop sports standard in schools and colleges, which organize specific sports and showing commendable results, need some technical support in terms of basic equipment or in some cases, financial and other support. The children are admitted in the age group of 10-18 years. At present there are **73** Extension Centers. The trainees admitted under the scheme are provided with Stipend of @Rs.6000/- per trainee for 10 months in a year, Competition Exposure @Rs.2000/- per trainee per year, Sports Kit @Rs.4000/- per trainee per year, Accidental Insurance @Rs.150/-

p.a. and to the institution to support infrastructure, equipment and financial support to the tune of @Rs.5000/- per trainee per year and not more than Rs.1.00 lac totally. Presently there are **73** STC/SAG Extension Centres in the country having a total strength of **1465** trainees (**953 Boys & 512 Girls**).

6. CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE: In order to provide second and third tier to the National Team, it was decided to start the Centre of Excellence Scheme to train those sports persons who have shown performance at National level competitions. The trainees in the age group of 14-25 years and above are admitted. Admission is also given to junior level sports persons who are in the verge of entering into the senior level and has potential to become international sport persons. At present there are 15 Centers of Excellence, Academic Institutions/Regional Centers/STC. The training is imparted in 18 disciplines all over the country. The trainees under residential schemes are provided Boarding lodging @Rs.225/- per head per day for 330 days, Sports Kit of @Rs.6000/- p.a., Accidental insurance @Rs.150/- p.a., Competition Exposure @Rs.6000/- p.a., Medical expenses @Rs.2000/- p.a., Other Expenses @Rs.850/- and the trainees under Non-Residential schemes are provided Sports Kit @Rs.6000/-, Competition Exposure @Rs.3000/-, Stipend @Rs.9000/- and Insurance @Rs.150/-. Presently there are **15** COE Centres in the country having a total strength of **426** trainees (**235 Boys & 191 Girls**).

7. SAI NATIONAL SPORTS ACADEMIES: The National Sports Academies forms are the latest offering in Sports Promotional Schemes of SAI. Various Sports Academies are being set up by SAI, in collaboration with the National Sports Federations to attract sports talent in respective discipline in the age group of 12-25 years. At present there are **05 Academies**. The Academy Scheme envisages modern training centres having good sports facilities, equipment, and requisite sports science infrastructure as well as qualified personnel to meet the daily requirement of the trainees. The Sports Academies will have both residential and non-residential trainees. It is envisaged that each Academy will function under tripartite agreement under PPP mode, wherein the roles of SAI, the concerned federation and the sponsor shall be defined. One of the major roles of the federations would be to provide greatest inputs through foreign expertise and MoUs with international bodies of the disciplines. The national federations will also make efforts to generate revenue through sponsorships or partnerships. Presently there are **05** Academies in the country having a total strength of **96** trainees (**59 Boys & 37 Girls**).
