(d) This Ministry maintains habitation-wise data and not village wise-data with regard to rural drinking water supply in the country. As per information reported by State Govt. of Maharashtra on Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of this Ministry, as on 01.04.2016, total number of habitations which are having assured potable water supply in the state is 87,814.

(e) & (f) Yes Madam. As reported by State Government of Maharashtra, there are total 12,252 partially covered / Water quality affected Habitations in the State as on 01.04.2016. Out of these, 1891 habitations would be covered in the Year 2016-17. Remaining 10361 Habitations will be covered in 5 years (from 2017-18 to 2021-22).
