TITLE IN

- (a): Construction of buildings/structures in the vicinity of airports in the country is regulated at present by the "Ministry of Civil Aviation (Height Restrictions for Safeguarding of Aircraft Operations) Rules, 2015" notified by Government of India vide GSR-751(E) dated 30th September, 2015 and the "Aircraft (Demolition of Obstructions caused by Buildings and Trees etc.) Rules, 1994".
- (b): Yes, Madam. The Aerodrome Operators regularly monitor the surroundings of airports for any violation of height of structures and initiate action with Urban Local bodies & State Administration for controlling obstructions as per the above rules.
- (c) & (d): Year wise details are being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.
