AAI has handed over about 417 hectares of land and the existing assets for the development of Nagpur Airport. Request for Qualification (RFQ) for upgradation and modernisation of the airport on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) basis through Public Private Partnership (PPP) has also been invited by MIHAN India Ltd (MIL) through global tender.
