(a) The Concept of Ganga Task Force is based on the existing Eco Task Force. It is envisaged that Ganga Task Force under National Mission for Clean Ganga shall be responsible for i) plantation of trees in upper reaches and banks of Ganga, ii) strengthening of pollution monitoring mechanism on ground, iii) management of public awareness and participation programmes, and (iv) assistance in management of Ghats especially during major congregations. Out of which they have started performing task related with plantation, awareness etc.
