Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a proposal sent by the Government of Andhra Pradesh regarding the release of the Rs. 146.30 crore for drinking water works/projects is pending with the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any action has been taken by the Government thereon and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time-frame fixed for the purpose?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Project proposals with an estimate cost of Rs. 135.75 crore and Rs. 10.73 crore (Rs. 146.48 Crore) from Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Smt. Butta Renuka regarding Multi-Villages Schemes and Single village Schemes for Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh had been received in the Ministry.

Although Rural Water Supply is a State subject, this Ministry supplements the efforts of the State Governments for rural drinking water supply by providing technical & financial assistance through Central Sponsored National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) as per the budgetary allocation for the same. Under NRDWP, the State Govt. plans, approves, executes and monitors water supply schemes / projects. As such, the proposal of the Hon'ble MP had been sent to the State Government on 30.09.2015.
