Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) the total amount of education cess collected by the Government in the last three years;

(b) the amount of education cess utilised for the required purpose during the above said period;

(c) the total unused amount available under the education cess;

(d) the details of the education cess distributed among the States, State-wise; and

(e) the steps Government taken to ensure full utilisation of the education cess?

(a): The total amount of education cess collected by the Government under direct and indirect taxes in the last three years is as under:-

(b) to (e) The Education Cess comprises of 2% Primary Education Cess (PEC) and 1% Secondary & Higher Education Cess (SHEC).

As per the Resolution dated 30.08.2006 on setting up of Prarambhik Shiksha Kosh (PSK) the fund collected through the PEC is credited to PSK and is used only to meet the part of expenditure on Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) & Mid-Day Meal (MDM) Scheme. The details of expenditure from PSK fund are as under:

Fund collected through PEC is not allocated State-wise.

For 1% Higher Education Cess, since there is no dedicated fund opened in Public Account, the entire proceeds (along with additional provision required for Higher Education) are allocated directly for utilization towards the dedicated purpose of higher education.

Ministry of Finance has given its concurrence for opening of a separate fund for crediting Higher Education Cess, called 'Madhyamik & Uchchatar Shiksha Kosh.
