2146. SHRI KESHAV PRASAD MAURYA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to introduce uniform system of medicine for each group;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of Central Government hospitals across the country and the number of people with serious ailments registered in those hospitals each day;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to make smart hospitals on the lines of smart city and smart railways; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

(a) to (e): Health is a State subject and no such information is maintained centrally. It is also the responsibility of the States/UTs to provide necessary health care facilities to the people. However, support is provided to States/UTs under National Health Mission (NHM), to strengthen their health system including support for mainstreaming of AYUSH, which includes integrating AYUSH practitioners within the primary health care delivery system through collection and contractual appointment of AYUSH doctors/paramedics and also providing support for AYUSH drugs. Such support is based on the requirement posed by the States/UTs in their Programme Implementation Plan.

There are four Central Government Hospitals in Delhi viz. Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. RML Hospital and Smt. Sucheta Kriplani Hospital and Kalawati Saran Children's Hospital.
