MINISTER AND THE ME ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI ARJUN RAM MEGHWAL)

- (a)to(d): India has so far posed the following three projects to the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB):
 - (i) Development of a Satellite Port of JNPT at Vadhavan, District Palghar, Maharashtra, for co-financing with the Asian Development Bank (ADB).
 - (ii) Development of a new Major Port at Colachel (Enayam) in Tamil Nadu, for co-financing with ADB.
 - (iii) AC Transmission System portion of Western Region (Raigarh) Southern Region (Pugalur North Trichur) HVDC Bipole Link Project to be implemented by the Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. (PGCIL), for a loan of US\$150 million.

After these projects are appraised, they will be taken up for review and approval by the Board of Directors of the AIIB. A firm timeline cannot be indicated at this stage.
