(a) to (c) With a view to promoting scientific understanding of the science and mathematics subjects, which is essential for facing the JEE-Advanced examination for admission into IITs, Government is starting the IIT-PAL initiative.

Under this, IIT Delhi will lead a team of expert teachers who would teach for free, Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics/Biology of 11th and 12th standard using the medium of Direct-to Home TV Channels starting from August 2016.
