- (c) whether the enquiry conducted at University of Hyderabad has raised several issues of legal and moral legitimacy;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the action taken/being taken by the Government to overcome the ideological battles prevailing in the institutions and bring normalcy in the universities drawing attention back to academics?

The Government has appointed a Commission of Inquiry consisting of Justice Ashok Kumar Roopanwal (Retired) to enquire into the events at the University of Hyderabad, culminating in the death of Shri Chakravarti R. Vemula, a research scholar in the University of Hyderabad. The report of the Commission is awaited.

(e). Universities being autonomous organizations are competent to deal with such matters themselves along with local authorities responsible for law and order.
