(a) to (d): Consequent upon the announcement in the budget speech, 2016-17, a regulatory architecture for enabling ten public and ten private institutions to emerge as World-Class Teaching and Research Institutions is being worked out. The selection of institutes to be world class shall be done after the regulatory architecture is finalised. Till date, no funds/incentives have been provided to any institution.
