**Aided Institutions in the North East**

**2427. SHRI NINONG ERING:**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Government aided schools and colleges in the North-East including Arunachal Pradesh;
- (b) whether the Government has released funds for these institutions timely and if so, the details thereof during the last three years, State-wise; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) Under Sarva Siksha Abhiyan (SSA), the number of Government aided elementary schools in the North East including Arunachal Pradesh is 8105. Under Rashtriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhiyan (RMSA), 1906 government aided secondary schools and 464 higher secondary schools are in the North East. There are 453 Colleges in the North East including Arunachal Pradesh which receive aid under the schemes dealt by University Grants Commission (UGC).

(b) & (c) Under Sarva Siksha Abhiyan (SSA) and Rashtriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhiyan (RMSA), funds are not are released directly to government aided schools but provided to State governments. The State-wise and year-wise details of funds released to the aided colleges in the North Eastern States by University Grants Commission (UGC) under their different schemes in the last three years is given at Annexure.
