2449. SHRIMATI POONAM MAHAJAN:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is looking to expand its ambit of artists and performers from different regions who can participate in the festivals organized abroad to boost the country's soft power globally;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken to ensure the adequate applications are received from artisans and performers from remote areas of the country;
- (c) whether the Government is taking appropriate measures to encourage and increase the number of artisans and performers from the North-East region; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?
