- (b) if so, the details thereof during the last three years and the current year, State-wise?

(a) & (b): The Government is establishing 5 new IITs and 4 new AIIMS in pursuance of the Budget Announcement 2014-15, and 1 new IIT and 6 new AIIMS, along with conversion of Indian School of Mines (ISM), Dhanbad into an IIT, in pursuance to the Budget Announcement 2015-16. The details of these IITs/ AIIMS are as under:
