(a) to (c): 'Some Inputs for the Draft National Education Policy, 2016' has been formulated by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (HRD), wherein it has been recommended that, at the national level, a Teacher Education University will be set up covering various aspects of teacher education and faculty development and the Regional Institutes of Education under NCERT will be developed and converted to Teacher Education Universities at the regional levels.
