(a) & (b): The National Disaster Management Plan (NDMP) has been released on 1st June, 2016.

The NDMP aims to make India disaster resilient and significantly reduce the loss of lives and assets. The National Plan has been aligned with the Sendai Framework of Action, which was agreed upon by 187 countries, including India, in March, 2015.

This plan covers all phases of disaster management – prevention, mitigation, response and recovery.
