COMPREHENSIVE SCHEME FOR VULNERABLE GROUPS

NO. 2776 SHRI R. PARTHIPAN:

WILL the MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has sufficient mechanism to address the occupational, residential and social vulnerabilities in urban areas in a comprehensive and integrated manner with targeted focus on the vulnerable groups;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the list of such programmes/schemes implemented by the Government; and
- (d) the details of fund allocation and utilization, State-wise for the last three years?

- (a) to (c): This Ministry has been implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM)" since September, 2013 by restructuring Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY) with a view to targeted focus on reducing poverty and

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vulnerability of urban poor households by providing them opportunities for earning their livelihoods on a sustainable basis. DAY-NULM encourages universal social mobilisation of urban poor into Self-Help Groups (SHGs) and their federations. Normally, women SHGs are formed, however male SHGs of persons with disabilities are also eligible. Skill training as per market demand and subsidised loans to urban poor to set up microenterprises or other self-employment ventures are provided. Also, urban homeless population is enabled access to shelters equipped with basic infrastructure facilities like water supply, sanitation, safety and security. The Scheme offers support to urban street vendors and addresses their livelihood concerns by facilitating survey, issue of certificate of vending and creation of infrastructure for street vending. The coverage of DAY-NULM extends to disadvantaged groups like SCs, STs, women, minorities, disabled etc.

- (d) The details of funds allocated and utilized, State-wise for the last three years under DAY-NULM are at Annexure.
