MEMU TRAINS IN BARODA DIVISION

† 2791. SHRIMATI DARSHANA VIKRAM JARDOSH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Keem, Ankleshwar and Bharuch stations on the Baroda Division are proposed to be provided with MEMU train service with 15 minutes frequency from Wapi which comes under Mumbai Central Division of Western Railway of Gujarat in view of the industrial development in these areas; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) Presently, Vapi is connected to Kim by 05 pairs of Mail/Express and 03 pairs of Passenger trains, Ankleshwar by 21 pairs of Mail/Express and 03 pairs of Passenger trains and Bharuch by 40 pairs of Mail/Expres and 03 pairs of Passenger trains, which are considered adequate for the present level of traffic. However, at present, there is no proposal to connect Vapi with Kim, Ankleshwar and Bharuch stations by MEMU train service due to operational and resource constraints.
