#### 2797. SHRI DEVENDRA SINGH BHOLE:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENTAND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of vocational training development projects being implemented in the Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) of different States including Uttar Pradesh; and
- (b) the number of ITIs of various States including Uttar Pradesh in which the work of said projects has been started State-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a). Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship is implementing following schemes in the Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) of different States including Uttar Pradesh:
- Externally Aided Project (EAP) World Bank assisted Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP): The Project envisages upgradation of 400 Government ITIs. 34 States /Union Territories(UTs) are participating under the project. The funding pattern between Center and State is 75: 25 (90:10 For NE States). The project started in Dec. 2007 and its closing date is September 2016.
- 2. Upgradation of 1396 Government ITIs through Public Private Partnership (PPP):A total of 1227 Government ITIs have been covered in 31 States/UTs except in the States of Manipur and Sikkim and the UTs of Andaman & Nicobar, Daman & Diu and Lakshadweep. Interest free loan @ Rs. 2.5 crore per ITI has been released to the 1227 ITIs releasing a total amount of Rs. 3067.50 crore. The fund was released directly to the Institute Management Committees (IMCs) Society of ITIs covered under the scheme.

- 3. Upgradation of Government ITIs into Model ITIs:Under the scheme, existing Government ITI in a State is being upgraded as Model ITI. IMC society is to be formed for each ITI with chairperson from Industry. The scheme was approved in Dec. 2014 for a total cost of Rs.300 crore. Implementation period is 3 years i.e. till FY 2016-17. The funding pattern between Center and State is 70: 30 (90:10 For NE States). So far, 25ITIs, have been identified for upgradation to Model ITIs.
- 4. Skill Development in 34 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism (LWE): The scheme was approved for implementation in March 2011 to enhance the infrastructure of Skill Development in Left Wing Extremism affected districts, so that the local people may get opportunity of skill development and have livelihood. The cost of the scheme is Rs. 241.65 crore. Under the scheme, establishment of 34 new ITIs in 34 districts of 9 States have been approved.
- (b). State-wise detailsof number of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) including Uttar Pradesh in which the work of said projects has started is attached as Annexure I.
