Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether National Building Construction Corporation (NBCC) has formulated a scheme for starting a project for low cost houses;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) whether private builders/colonisers are not giving houses even after taking money;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken/being taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to encourage affordable housing project by NBCC and other public sector companies to achieve the target of housing for all?

- (a) & (b): NBCC (India) Limited (formerly known as National Building Construction Corporation Limited) has informed that it has constructed low cost houses in various cities of India including Gurgaon (Haryana), Khekra (Uttar Pradesh) and Alwar (Rajasthan).
