#### **CHANGES AT METRO STATION**

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether some changes have been made in regard to passenger handling in the recent past at HUDA City Centre Metro Station;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether proper security audit has been undertaken before effecting changes particularly from the point of new exit gates to thwart any security lapse from that side; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. (DMRC)
has informed that HUDA City Centre Metro Station has been
remodelled to facilitate commuter movement as detailed below:

- 6 entry and 10 exit Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) gates
   have been added to reduce waiting time;
- 4 numbers of escalators have been provided to facilitate exit from the first floor;
- c) To reduce congestion inside the station premises, Ticket Office Machines (TOMs) have been shifted outside and numbers of TOMs increased;
- d) Dedicated entry and exit for passenger has been provided from ground level and concourse level respectively; and
- (e) Lift no. 2, connecting concourse and platform no. 2 of the station has been programmed in such a manner so that it is available at concourse level for the convenience of commuters.
- (c)&(d): DMRC informed that the revised plan has been implemented in consultation with Central Industrial Security Force (CISF).
