- (a) whether an over bridge near Hazaribagh Road (Jharkhand) railway station has not been constructed despite approval having been granted;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to take up construction of the said over bridge at an early date;
- (c) if so, the details thereof an if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the present status of the said Bridge?

(a) to (d): Work of construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB) in lieu of Level Crossing (LC) No.20/B/T between Hazaribagh Road – Keshwari Railway Stations in East Central Railway was sanctioned on cost sharing basis at a total cost of 019.33 crores (Railways' share as 07.92 crores and State Government's share as 011.41 crores). Tender for design of structure has been finalised.
