Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has decided to set up 50 Global Skill Banks to train potential immigrant workers in various job roles as per international standards;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Indian workers skilled in various fields interested for overseas employment would be trained in such Skill Banks; and

(d) if so, the likely benefit to be accrued to the Government by setting up of Skill Banks?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

(a) to (d): The Government aims to bridge global shortage of labour force in the coming years by reaping the demographic dividend of young Indian labour force. With this aim, the Government has established 15 International Skill Training Centres in key migratory pockets of the Country on pilot basis on the occasion of World Skills Day on 15th July, 2016. A Statement showing the details of these centers are annexed (Annexure I).

The trainings imparted in these Centres are of International Benchmark standards apart from compliant to Qualifications Packs (QPs) and National Occupation Standards (NOSs) aligned to National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) with options for Pre-departure orientation and soft skills training. These Centres train Indian youth aspiring and willing to migrate overseas for employment, thereby enabling right match of aspirants with employment opportunity overseas.
