- (a) whether it is a fact that the guidelines for safety, welfare and health of coal mine workers have not been reviewed for the last many years in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps proposed to be taken thereon;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to review the provisions of the Mines Act, 1952 and regulations framed for coal mines; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a)&(b):The Directorate-General of Mines Safety (DGMS) under the Union Ministry of Labour& Employment (MoLE) administers the implementation of provisions of mine safety regulation and issues guidelines to industries for safety / welfare of coal mines workers on a regular basis in the form of technical circulars as well safety alerts and the same are complied with by theindustry. The number of technical circulars issued by DGMS during last three years and current year are furnished in the table below:
