Drinking Water and Sanitation in Tribal/Backward Areas

3047. SHRI NISHIKANT DUBEY:

Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has allocated/released funds for tribal and backward areas of Jharkhand for drinking water and sanitation; and

(b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last two years and the current year, State-wise?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

(a)&(b) Yes Madam. Under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), this Ministry earmarks 10 % of NRDWP allocation for coverage of Scheduled Tribes concentrated rural habitations. However, the Ministry does not release / earmark fund separately for backward area with regard to drinking water supply. The details of funds released to all States including Jharkhand during last two years and current year for Scheduled Tribes concentrated habitations is at **Annexure – I**.

As regards, Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) (SBM - G), State/UT-wise, Central share released in Schedule Tribes (STs) dominated districts during last 2 years and current year under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) as per Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) is at **Annexure-II**.
