Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of water projects including Salgaon Project were started three decades back with a view to solve the water problem of Rajasthan particularly Mount Abu Region;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons for the delay in their implementation;
- (c) the total cost of each such project alongwith the land acquired for Salgaon project; and
- (d) whether the Government has prescribed any time limit for the completion of the projects in view of the acute shortage of ground water in Mount Abu Region and if so, the details thereof alongwith the steps taken in this direction?
