Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that solar energy projects are achieving great heights in energy sector;
- (b) is so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to make arrangements for meeting the energy requirements of Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana through renewable energy sources;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government also proposes to provide assistance for the setting up of small solar projects under the said Yojana including land for the same; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

**(a) & (b):** Yes Madam. Government of India has set target of 1,00,000 MW of solar power by 2022. State wise grid connected power projects installed is given in Annexure

**(c) & (d):** As of now, there is no separate scheme for meeting the energy requirements of Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana. However, Ministry can provide Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for the proposals received from Hon'ble Member of Parliament under off-grid and Decentralized Solar Application Programme for the systems like Solar Street Lights, Power Plants for Panchayats/Schools/Hospitals etc. and Solar Pumps for drinking water in accordance with scheme guidelines.

**(e) & (f):** Ministry provides Central Financial Assistance for installation of small power plants throughout the country, but land has to be made available locally.
