DDU-ANTYODAYA YOJANA

3120. PROF. PREM SINGH CHANDUMAJRA:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana, National Rural Livelihoods Mission—NRLM for skill development among youth;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the works undertaken under the said scheme, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to expand this scheme to cover all the rural areas of the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof including the rural areas covered presently and the additional rural areas proposed to be covered thereunder, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) the funds allocated, released and utilised till date, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT
(SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a): The Government is undertaking National Rural Livelihood Mission for enhancing livelihood of rural poor, including through skill development of rural youth. In November 2015, the program was announced as Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana (DAY-NRLM).

(b): The Government is undertaking two schemes for training rural youth under DAY-NRLM. The details of the two schemes are as below:

- (i) Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETI), which provides entrepreneurship development, enables the trainee to take bank credit and start his/her own Micro-enterprise. Some of the trainees seek regular jobs also.
- (ii) Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is a placement linked skill development program.

Total number of rural youth skilled under DDU-GKY and RSETI during FY 2015-16, State/UT-wise is given below:-

(c) & (d): DDU-GKY is applicable for rural poor candidates in all villages. Similarly, Government has decided to set up one RSETI in each District of the country.

(e): A total of Rs.600 crore has been allocated for DDU-GKY, and Rs. 100 crore allocated for RSETI under Budget Estimate 2016-17. DDU-GKY is a demand based program. Funds released for DDU- GKY and funds utilized under RSETI, State/UT-wise in the FY 2016-17 are given below:
