Cleaning of Iconic Places

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken a decision for cleaning of ten iconic places under the Swachh Bharat Mission;
- (b) if so, the funds allocated for the purpose and the names of such iconic places in the country including Punjab, Gujarat and Jharkhand, location-wise, State/ UT-wise;
- (c) the criteria for selection of these places;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to extend this cleaning drive to other tourist/religious places with large pot falls and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the Government has roped in public sector companies such as NALCO and Hindustan Zinc to fund a part of its Swachh Bharat Mission, and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) and (b) On pilot basis 10 iconic places have been identified to be cleaned up in 1st Phase. All the Stakeholders, who are responsible for upkeep of these iconic places, that includes the Local Administration, Tourism Department, Archaeological Survey of India etc. have been advised to

prepare their plan along with expenditure to be incurred and sources/schemes from where the funds are to be dovetailed. State-wise, name of iconic tourist places to be cleaned is as under :

1	Assam	Kamakhya Temple
2	Andhra Pradesh	Tirupati Temple
3.	Jammu & Kashmir	Vaishno Devi Temple
4.	Odisha	Jagannath Puri Temple
5.	Maharashtra	Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus
6.	Punjab	Golden Temple
7.	Rajasthan	Ajmer Sharif Dargah
8.	Tamilnadu	Meenakshi Temple
9.	Uttar Pradesh	Taj Mahal, Manikarnika Ghat, Varanasi

(c) These places have been selected based on cultural, historical, religious and touristic importance.

(d) Government has plan to clean 100 iconic sites in India. On pilot basis 10 iconic places have been identified to be cleaned up in 1st Phase.

(e) As part of making iconic places Swachh, NALCO and Hindustan Zinc have adopted Jagannath Puri Temple and Ajmer Sharif Dargah respectively.
