FAKE CURRENCY NOTES

3332. SHRI M. CHANDRAKASI:

QUESTION

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of fake currency notes out of the total currency notes in circulation in the country, denomination-wise during the last three years;
- (b) the details regarding safety measures available for common man who unwittingly happen to possess fake currency notes due to transactions in the retail market against prosecution; and
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to provide free fake-currency checking facilities by installing Currency Note Sorting machines in banks/ important public places, etc. and if so, the details thereof?

(a) As per available data on Notes In Circulation (NIC), from Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and seized and recovered fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN), from National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB), denomination-wise percentage is as given in the following table

(b) In terms of RBI's Master Circular dated July 20, 2016 on Detection and Impounding of counterfeit notes by banks, for cases of detection of counterfeit notes upto 4 pieces in a single transaction, only a consolidated report is sent by the bank to Police Authority along with suspect counterfeit notes at the end of the month. For cases of detection of counterfeit notes of 5 or more pieces in a single transaction, counterfeit notes should be forwarded by the bank to the local police for investigation by filing an FIR.

(c) RBI has been advised to install Note-sorting machine at identified places to facilitate checking of FICN.
