(a) The number of persons saved by Indian Coast Guard during Search and Rescue (SAR) operations and medical evacuations during the last three years is as follows:

2013	583	10
2014	332	28
2015	356	29
2016 (till date)	215	12

(b) & (c): In an expanding organization like the Indian Coast Guard, the increase in strength is a continuous process. The sanctioned strength of Coast Guard has increased from 8,006 in 2009 to 15,265 at present.
