- (a) to (c): A six member all women officer crew of the Indian Navy undertook a maiden open ocean voyage on board the Navy's sailing vessel, Mhadei, from Goa to Mauritius and back from 24th May to 8th July 2016. The expedition covered over 5000 Nm at sea. A total expenditure of Rs. 28 lakhs was incurred on this expedition.
- (d) The Indian Navy is also training an all women crew to undertake sea circumnavigation of the globe scheduled in end 2017.
