Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the ongoing peace talks with surrendered ULFA of Assam;
- (b) the number of ULFA militants led by Poresh Baruah opposing the peace talks as on date;
- (c) whether ULFA brigade have been strengthening its cadre by recruiting many youths in the last couple of years and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Indian Agencies have approached international agencies including Interpol in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the progress made so far?

(a) to (e): After signing SoO Agreement on 03.09.2011 between the Government of India, Government of Assam and the ULFA (pro-Talk), peace process has been facilitated and the anti-talk faction has been weakened considerably by counter insurgency operations.
