- (d) the preventive action taken by the Government to check such unpleasant situations?

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(a) & (b): The details of ceasefire violations on India-Pakistan border are as under:-

(d) Appropriate retaliation to the ceasefire violations, as required, has been carried out by Indian Army / BSF. In addition, all violations of ceasefire are taken up with Pakistan authorities at the appropriate level through the established mechanism of hotlines, flag meetings as well as weekly talks between the Directorate Generals of Military Operations of the two countries. BSF, too, holds talks at various levels with its counterparts viz. Pakistan Rangers.
