(a) whether National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) has accepted the suggestion of including women empowerment, inclusive education and industry-academia linkages as the additional parameters of providing ratings;

(b) if so, the the share of the said components in deciding the rating by NAAC in overall rating process with the details of how empowerment and inclusive education would be quantified in parameters;

(c) the time by which these parameters will be included in the NAAC ratings; and

(d) if not, the reasons for not accepting these parameters to be included in the rating system?
