- (a) whether the prices of Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) is less than the prices of petrol and if so, the details thereof along with the reasons for the difference in their prices;
- (b) whether the Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) are incurring losses due to low prices of ATF; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto along with the corrective steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard?

(a): Prices of Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) and Petrol have been made market determined by the Government effective 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2001 and 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 respectively. Since then, the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) take appropriate decision on pricing of these products in line with their international prices and other market conditions. The price build up of ATF (Domestic) and Petrol as on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2016 is given below:
