3553. SHRI NAGENDRA KUMAR PRADHAN:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that some Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country are working up to 10th class only and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to upgrade such Kendriya Vidyalayas from class 10th to 12th;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the number and name of the schools upgraded, State/UT-wise;
- (d) the principles followed for upgradation to class 12th in Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country; and
- (e) whether Deogarh Kendriya Vidyalaya, Odisha is also under consideration for the said purpose and if so, the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

- (a) 151 Kendriya Vidyalayas in the country have classes upto 10th only. The details are annexed.
- (b) (c) & (d) Kendriya Vidyalayas are upgraded from class 10th to 12th taking into account the number of children seeking admission in any of the three streams viz. Science, Humanities and Commerce as well as availability of adequate infrastructure.
- (e) Kendriya Vidyalaya, Deogarh has been upgraded upto class-XI from the academic session 2016-17.
