Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to expand and strengthen the polytechnic education in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the norms/criteria for establishing a new polytechnic institute in the country;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to establish a number of new polytechnic institutes across the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MAHENDRA NATH PANDEY)

(a) to (e) : Polytechnics are established and administered by the concerned State Governments. A scheme, namely, "Sub-Mission on Polytechnics" was started by the Government in the year 2008. Under the scheme, this Ministry provides one-time financial assistance upto Rs.12.30 crores per polytechnic to the State/UT Governments for setting up of new polytechnics in 300 un-served and under-served districts of the country. The concerned State Government will provide the land and also meet the 100% recurring expenditure. The list of the districts selected is given at **Annexure**. This Ministry also provides financial assistance to 500 Government and Government aided polytechnics subject to a maximum of Rs 2.00 crores per polytechnic to upgrade infrastructure facilities like labs, equipments, etc. Apart from this, the Government has also approved a scheme for construction of women's hostels in 500 existing polytechnics in the country.
