370. SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any representation has been received from the State Government of Kerala for referring some controversial political murders to CBI and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that several political murders/atrocities/ criminal attacks are prevalent in the northern part of Kerala; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HANSRAJ GANGARAM AHIR)

(a) to (c): As per available information the Government of Kerala had requested the Central Government to entrust the investigation of crime No. 780/2014 registered at Kathirur Police Station, District Kannur, relating to murder of Shri Elamthottathil Manoj, and crime No. 85/2014 registered at Edacherry Police Station, relating to murder of Shri T.P. Chandrashekharan, to CBI. The investigation of crime No. 780/2014 was entrusted to the CBI in October, 2014, but crime no. 85/2014 was not found to be a fit case for investigation by CBI.
