Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state :

- (a) whether there are any guidelines with regard to cutting down of old trees in a phased manner and planting new trees in place of the same;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether old trees are producing only carbon dioxide after a lapse of certain period; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken by the Government to allow cutting down of old trees and plantation of new plants throughout the country?

- (a) & (b) The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has not issued any guidelines with regard to cutting down of old trees and replacing with new trees.
- (c) & (d) As per some published research work, old trees are not net 'Carbon dioxide generators'.
