ANIMAL HEALTH CARD SCHEME

3803. SHRI RAMESH CHANDER KAUSHIK:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और कृषक कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to launch an Animal Health Card Scheme in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of funds allocated by the Government under this scheme so far, State-wise including Haryana;
- (c) whether there is a proposal with the government to increase the availability of disease free germplasm through e-market under the animal welfare scheme;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to implement the scheme in the entire country?

ANSWER

- (a) to (e) Yes, Madam. The Government of India is contemplating to initiate “National Mission on Bovine Productivity (NMBP)” with following four components:
- (i) *Pashu Sanjivni*: an Animal Wellness Programme encompassing provision of Animal Health cards (*Nakul Swasthya Patra*) along with UID identification and uploading data on National Data Base;
 - (ii) Advanced breeding Technology: including Assisted Reproductive Technique-IVF/MOET and sex sorted semen technique to improve availability of disease free high genetic merit female bovines;
 - (iii) Creation of “E- *Pashudhan Haat*”-*Nakul Prajnan Bajar*: an e-market portal for bovine germplasm for connecting breeders and farmers and
 - (v) National Bovine Genomic Centre for Indigenous breeds (NBGCIB).
