- (a) the total number of States in the country which are included in the National Horticulture Mission (NHM) during the year 2015-16;
- (b) whether it is also fact that Himachal Pradesh has also been included in the Mission by the Government; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the amount released by the Government to the State under NHM for the year, 2015-16?

(a) & (b): Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), a Centrally Sponsored Scheme is being implemented for holistic growth of the horticulture sector from financial year 2014-15. MIDH has following sub-schemes and area of operation:

- National Horticulture Mission (NHM)
- Horticulture Mission for North East & Himalayan States (HMNEH)
- National Agro forestry & Bamboo Mission (NABM)
- National Horticulture Board (NHB)
- Coconut Development Board (CDB)
- And Central Institute for Horticulture (CIH), Nagaland

8 (eight) North Eastern and 3 (three) Himalayan states, including Himachal Pradesh are included in the Horticulture Mission for North East & Himalayan States (HMNEH). Remaining 18 (Eighteen) states are included in National Horticulture Mission (NHM).

(c): During the Financial Year 2015-16, Rs.2449.40 Lakh was released as central share to Himachal Pradesh for implementation of MIDH/HMNEH.
