- (b) the details of the financial assistance provided to the States under GIM and the amount utilized so far, State-wise?

(a) The National Mission for a Green India (GIM) is currently being implemented in nine States namely Uttarakhand, Punjab, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Mizoram, Manipur and Kerala. Proposals have been received from 14 other States namely Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Tamil Nadu, Meghalaya, Maharashtra, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Sikkim, Madhya Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Tripura, which are under examination/consideration.

(b) Details of financial assistance provided to the States under GIM and the amount utilized so far is given below:
