Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of police stations brought under the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS) Project in the country, State-wise;**
- (b) whether some States have not joined this project and if so, the reasons therefor; and**
- (c) the steps taken by the Government for implementation of the project in all the States at the earliest?**

(a) State/UT wise details of the Police Stations covered under the CCTNS project are at Annexure-I. Out of 14999 Police Stations 12665 are using the CCTNS application software for updating crime related data to the system.

(b) The states of Bihar and Rajasthan, which are encountering delays in engaging their Systems Integrators are at present not using CCTNS software application.

(c) The project is being regularly monitored in co-ordination with States/UTs, system integrators and implementing partners, with a view to meet the implementation schedule of March, 2017.
