- (b) whether it is a fact that the issue poses a serious threat to global security and endangers peace, health and stability in the country and if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps taken by the Government thereon?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Some instances of smuggling of Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN), illegal arms, ammunition and narcotics, have come to notice in India also. The Government has taken initiatives to prevent drug trafficking and reduce both supply and demand of drugs by
