RAIL HALT

3958. SHRI NISHIKANT DUBEY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposal for rail halt at Saliya in between Madhupur-Jasidih stations on Dhanpatdih-Sarsa-Bhagalpur-Dumka rail line;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is considering this proposal; and
- (d) if so, the detail thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (c): There is no proposal for any passenger halt at Saliya, between Madhupur and Jasidih stations over Asansol division of Eastern Railway. However, a proposal for passenger halt at Saliya between Kumerdol and Pandetola stations on Manderhil-Hasdiya section over Malda Division was received but not found desirable due to close proximity of less than 5 kms distance from both the adjacent stations and considering the fact that another halt station named Danre is already operational in the same block section.
