ATOMIC REACTORS

4004. DR. THOKCHOM MEINYA:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Russia is supplying two additional atomic reactors for the Kudankulam Nuclear Power Plant (NPP) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Russia is ready to transfer certain technologies relating to building of Indo-Russian nuclear power stations in other third world countries; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR, PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) Yes, Sir. A techno-commercial offer for Units-5&6 (2X1000 MW) at Kudankulam has been made by the Russian Federation, in addition to Units-1&2 (2X1000 MW) which are nearing completion and Units-3&4 (2X1000 MW), work on which has started.
- (b) No, Sir.
- (c) Does not arise in view of (b) above.
